


FINANCIAL INCLUSIVENESS OF THE POOR BEYOND MICROFINANCE









This book addresses several issues in developing the Islamic microfinance institutions. The most challenging issues for microfinance institution is between exclusion and inclusion. Customers are excluded from the main mainstream financial institutions but they are included in the Islamic microfinance institutions. Islamic microfinance institutions have potential to grow due to their ability to bring financial access to an underserved market and due to the growing size of this market, the world's poorest. However, Islamic microfinance institutions might fail to serve the targeted group. These failures might be due to the following reasons: many Islamic microfinance institutions never reach either the minimal scale or the efficiency level necessary to cover costs; many Islamic microfinance institutions face non-supportive policy frameworks and daunting physical, social and economic challenges; some Islamic microfinance institutions fail to manage their funds adequately enough to meet future cash needs and as a result faced liquidity problems; and some Islamic microfinance institutions had neither the financial management systems nor the skills required to run a successful operation.





When Najib Razak became Prime Minister of Malaysia in April 2009 he was immediately faced with a crisis. A precipitous decline in exports in the wake of the global financial crisis had left the economy teetering on recession, while efforts to release the country from the fiscal straitjacket imposed by heavy fuel and other subsidies inherited from previous administrations had produced a surge in inflation.

Najib is the first trained economist to head the government in the nation's history. What role did he play in this economics transformation? And to what extent have the unpopular economic policies he pursued contributed to this success? Eschewing the political rhetoric that has become so common when discussing the Malaysian economy in recent years, this book seeks to answer such questions.






THE NEW ECONOMIC POLICY IN MALAYSIA






DEMOGRAPHIC TRANSITION AND SOCIO-ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN MALAYSIA

Malaysia has put in place the various mechanisms in development planning to improve human capital. Consequently, Malaysia has done well to realize the demographic dividend in achieving rapid socio-economic development, which in turn affected the demographic processes.

The introductory chapter of this book elucidates the linkages between population and development, with particular reference to Malaysia. Chapters 2 to 4 present an update of the demographic situation in Malaysia in terms of changes in the population structure, fertility, and mortality. 


THE GLOBAL MACRO ECONOMY AND FINANCE


